ABINGDON WORKS CAR SHOW – 2002

August Bank Holiday Monday (26th August) sees a special celebration in Abingdon-on-Thames when we once again welcome as many cars as possible of the different makes that started their existence in the famous motor factory in this small Berkshire (as it then was) market town.

Following the enjoyable day spent last year we have a different format for 2002, while retaining and improving the fundamentals of the event. Although for the past two years the show has been held along with a local gala, this year we are majoring on our classic car show and including supporting acts to provide wider appeal to the passengers and those who prefer a more varied day out.

This year we are having a Thames theme – after all, Abingdon is still very much “on-Thames”- although the local authority signage seems to have dropped half the name for convenience!

In stead of the simple drive around the old factory test routes we shall have 3 road runs following the route of the Thames to Abingdon, with start points in Abingdon (for local drivers, travelling out and back), Marlow downstream and from the Thames source near Cirencester. All routes will finish with a common route through Abingdon-on-Thames and into the event.

All very much a part of Abingdon the BMC Competition Department cars will be joined by Austin Healeys, MGs, Rileys and Morris Minor variants.

In 2002 cars from the “Works” are celebrating some important birthdays – the MGB is 40years old and to top that the Austin Healey marque is now 50 years old – we shall be planning some special celebrations so let’s have as many cars as can be mustered, and make it a big, big day. Remember it doesn’t have to be an old car, we’d love to see MG Z’s and the reborn *TF* too!

The nominal charge for each car, with occupants, will be £7.50 including entrance, route book for your chosen route and commemorative bumper plaque.
